
As of 01.01.2013 – 780,4 thousand people



Amount of produced sea biological resources, thousand tons






4th place among the subjects of the North-Western Federal District in the investment rating of Russian regions in 2012-2013.

The region is in the group IC5 (level stable) according to the rating of investment attractiveness of Russian regions

Murmansk region will enter the top ten regions of Russia with propitious conditions for doing business according to the ratings of leading international and Russian rating agencies

Murmansk region will consolidate the functions of the main scientific, human, cultural and business center of the Arctic, as well as the main center of service provision of maritime activity in the Arctic zone of the Russian Federation

BREAKDOWN OF TRADE TURNOVER BETWEEN THE MURMANSK REGION AND FINLAND




In 1st half of 2014 trade turnover - 61,2 million USD:

- Finland is the 5th main foreign trade partner after the Netherlands and China, Norway and Germany;

- Export to Finland – 6,5 million USD (Apatite, Metals, Wood and Berries)

- Import from Finland – 54, 7 million USD (Copper Stein, Equipment, Transport, Meat Vegetables)


